



How to Put an RSS Feed on Your Blog

Putting an RSS feed on your blog will enable you to get fresh content and news about the topic you love most without having to surf the web to find it. You can use this content on your blog if you want, since that is the purpose of it. Or you can simply read it for your own enjoyment. If you display it on your site, make sure you don't use the content as your own. Make it plain that it is coming from an external link.

It is quite easy to Place an RSS feed button on your blog if you use a free tool to do so. Why make anything harder than it needs to be? Simply go to [TotallyFreeBlogTools.com](#). You can take your choice of many different types of buttons from different places. All you need to do is tick their boxes and the code will be automatically generated. Highlight the code and copy it onto your own website and hey presto! You will have RSS feed.

If your blog is on MySpace, you will need to do it differently since MySpace does not allow the addition of JavaScript in profiles. Going to [Widgetbox.com](#) and creating something called a blidget - a flash-based RSS widget - can overcome this.

You need to create an account at widgetbox, log in then click on the 'make a blidget' button that you'll see on the page. There you will find a space called 'Your Blog URL Field'. Enter the URL of the RSS feed you want. If you don't know it, you can just put the URL of the blog instead - only this makes it a bit slower.

You can adjust the color, width and title to fit into your MySpace profile. What title do you want? An eye-catching one will help others to find it. You can choose an image for the header, tags and description for the same reason. Now click on the publish blidget button. Nope, you can't copy and paste the code - it won't be clickable if you do.

Instead on the next page click on the 'add to MySpace button. If you decide that what you've got is not big enough, click on 'get a bigger blidget' then the Add to MySpace button. This allows widgetbox to add more code that makes your button clickable. You'll also need to enter your email address and password in the appropriate boxes.

Decide what section of your profile you want the blidget to appear. Click on OK. You'll see the blidget appear at the bottom of your chosen section. If you change your mind about where you want it to appear, don't worry, it can now be moved by cut and paste in your MySpace page.
